Numbers 24 : 1-9

Was it a curse for Israel?

Read what happens
1 Samuel 25:39-42

Her concern for David's calling resulted in a blessed or cursed life for Abigail?

When Joseph's brothers sold him in to slavery, he ended up in Egypt. When the master saw that the Lord was with him, he made Joseph the overseer of his kingdom.

Read what happens
Genesis 39:5

He was an Israelite living in Egypt, but was he blessed or cursed?

Upon the death of their husbands, Ruth, a Moabite woman refuses to leave her Israelite mother-in-law in loneliness. Ruth vows to Naomi, "Where you go, I will go, and where you stay, I will stay. Your people will be my people; your God will be my God."

Read what happens
Ruth 4:13-22

Was Ruth's life blessed or cursed?

When Caleb returned from spying out the Promised Land, the other travelers with him complained and spoke against the Israelite's ability to take on the giants in the land. Caleb, however, said, "Let us go at once and take possession for we are able to overcome it."

Read what happens
Numbers 14:36-38

Was Caleb blessed or cursed?

When Jericho resident, Rahab, hides two Israelite spies, she lies to the King's messenger and says that the men left town. The spies promise to save her family when the day of battle comes.

Read what happens
Joshua 6:24

When Jericho fell, was it a curse for Rahab?

When the Queen of Sheba traveled to Jerusalem to meet King Solomon, she took him many gifts. She praised him for his ability to serve his God and people so well. She was overwhelmed by what she saw and honored the Israelite King greatly with her words.

Read what happens
2 Chronicles 9:12

How did the trip end for the Queen?

When Jael drove a tent peg into the head of the Canaanite army commander, her actions caused Israel's military success.

Read what happens
Judges 5:24-27

Did Israel's judge, Deborah, consider Jael a curse or a blessing?

Mordecai followed the ways of the Jewish people and refused to bow to Haman. Haman vowed not only to destroy Mordecai but the entire Jewish population within the kingdom. Mordecai would not change his ways.

Read what happens
Esther 9:3,4

Mordecai stood strong! Was he blessed or cursed?

After the Lord asks Abram to leave his country, family and friends, He makes a promise that still belongs to Israel and us as believers in Jesus Christ.

Read what happens
Genesis 12: 1-3

Even today, if one opposes Israel, is it a blessing or a curse?
