Watchman On the Wall Pendant

Materials needed:

Copies of Watchman on the Wall pendant downloaded from DPPJ Website - 1 for each child and 1 to use as a sample

 $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x 11" white tag or coverstock with the pendant copied onto it 1 for each child and 1 to use as a sample

18" pieces of dark blue yarn or roving - 1 for each child and 1 to use as a sample.

Child-sized scissors for each student

Hole punchers

Crayons and or markers

- 1. Have each child color a copy of the pendant.
- 2. They will then cut out around the outside of the pendant. Assist each child as needed with the cutting.
- 3. Punch two holes in the top of the pendant where indicated. Older children (5 6 yrs old) may be able to do this step. Younger children will need you to do this for them.
- 4. Lace the yarn through the holes and tie a knot to fit around each child's neck.



You can pre-cut, punch and lace the pendants ahead of time. The children will only need to color the pendants.
